 Absolutely not. We will continue to be subject to Section 87 of the Indian Act. Our Chiefs are adamant that taxation by the Crown is foreign taxation, and will fight to ensure that will always be the case. The Governance Agreement will not abrogate from (overrule) or derogate from (diminish) our Aboriginal and Treaty Rights, including our right to tax exemption.
